Event Management – Corporate Ninjas

You will be learning techniques and ideas that are not used by many event managers. Corporate ninjas require extensive survival techniques when managing multilevel and multimodal events and you will learn skills that will allow you to prosper in any situation. These survival techniques range from initiating a project through to writing up an evaluation that documents the lessons learnt as the event is closed out. As with any training, gaining expertise as a corporate ninja is about learning from your mistakes as well as learning to do the simple things better.

You do not need to be an expert in Event Management to do this course. You will be trained from any level of expertise and knowledge you have to become an event manager with ninja status.

Generic skills that are considered across all the subjects in the Digital Technologies faculty include:

- File management and backup procedures
