Media – Film 101

Media is a way of seeing how Art, Literature, Photography, Film, Animation and Digital Art communicate ideas. What makes an idea more popular than another? Who decides what's in and what's not?

The power of the media can influence how you think about things. This media elective will explore historical, contemporary, and future perspective on media, as an industry and its global influence. You will analyse the nature, function and extent of media influence as a critical reviewer of media culture and will produce genre specific video clips in order to reach target audiences.

Generic skills include the ability to:

- Read, critique, analyse, discuss and respond to various contemporary and classical imaginative texts
- Present complex ideas and information imaginatively to an audience.
- Use the mechanics of language accurately and effectively in written and oral responses
- Utilise ICT in the research, creating and presenting of at least one assessment task

Subject specific skills are:

- You will develop critical thinking skills
- You will develop research skills
- You will develop oral presentation skills
- You will develop collaborative skills
- You will use ICT, camera, editing software and production techniques and post production techniques
