Media – Video Production

If you are interested in creating images to represent your ideas, this elective gives you a professional and practical working knowledge in video/digital production. You will create digital video productions, exploring ideas in the form of scripts, storyboard designs and a research folio before filming and editing two complete productions. You will also analyse the film making techniques of popular and classic films, exploring the creative contributions of the people associated with their production.

Generic skills include the ability to:

- Read, critique, analyse, discuss and respond to various contemporary and classical imaginative media texts
- Present complex ideas and information imaginatively to an audience
- Use the mechanics of language accurately and effectively in written and oral responses
- Utilise ICT in research, creating and presenting for assessment tasks

Subject skills are:

- You will develop critical thinking skills
- You will develop visual design skills
- You will develop oral presentation skills
- You will create a coherent media production design plan including a script, storyboard with visual and technical direction
- You will use ICT, camera, editing software and production techniques and post production techniques

Please Note: A subject levy applies to this subject (see Subject Cost Schedule for details). Students wishing to undertake this subject must have access to a video camera, and be able to bring it to school on occasions as required.
