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# VCE UNITS INFORMATION

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## VCE DRAMA UNITS 1 AND 2 CONTINUED

### Unit 2

- Students should be able to use a range of stimulus material to create a solo or ensemble performance work as well as document and record the play-making techniques used to shape and develop this performance work
- Students should be able to demonstrate the effective use and manipulation of dramatic elements, theatrical conventions and stagecraft in the presentation of a performance work to an audience
- Students should be able to analyse and evaluate the creation, development and performance of characters, as well as the use and manipulation of theatrical conventions, stagecraft and dramatic elements as applied to the performance style/s of the student's own performance work
- Students should be able to identify use of theatrical conventions, describe performance style/s and analyse and evaluate how dramatic elements have been used in a drama performance

## ASSESSMENT

### Unit 1

- Outcomes 1, 2 and 3 are all based on the student's devised ensemble performance. Students are assessed on creating their piece, performing their piece and analysing the finishing product. Outcome 4 is based on the analysis of a professional production which requires students to attend the theatre

### Unit 2

- Outcomes 1, 2 and 3 are all based on the student's devised solo performance. Students are assessed on creating their piece, performing their piece and analysing the finishing product. Outcome 4 is based on the analysis of a professional production which requires students to attend the theatre

## PREREQUISITES

There are no prerequisites for this subject, however, it is highly recommended that students have undertaken Drama as a subject in Year 9 and/or Year 10.
