
VCE UNITS INFORMATION

VCE MUSIC PERFORMANCE UNITS 3 AND 4 CONTINUED

ASSESSMENT

The student's level of achievement for Units 3 and 4 will be determined by School Assessed Coursework and two end of year examinations.

Contributions to final assessment:

- Unit 3 School Assessed Coursework: 20% of the final assessment
- Unit 4 School Assessed Coursework: 10% of the final assessment
- End of year performance examination: 50% of the final assessment
- End of year aural and written examination: 20% of the final assessment

The student will give a live performance in only one of the following contexts:

- As a member of a group or
- As a soloist

Duration of examination:

- One assessed performer – 25 minutes
- Two or three assessed performers – 30 minutes
- Four assessed performers – 35 minutes
- Five or six assessed performers – 40 minutes

PREREQUISITES

There are no prerequisites for this subject, however, it is highly recommended that:

- Students have undertaken Units 1 and 2 in this subject
- Students on violin or piano forte have a minimum 7th grade AMEB or equivalent standard for solo performance
- Students on all other instruments, including voice, have a minimum 5th grade AMEB or equivalent standard for solo performance
- Students are currently undertaking instrumental lessons on their chosen instrument
