OUTCOMES

Unit 4

In Area of Study 1, students should be able to use comparative analysis and evaluation methods to make judgments about commercial product design and development.

In Area of Study 2, students should be able to continue to develop and safely manufacture the product designed in Unit 3, using materials, tools, equipment and machines, and record and monitor the production processes and modifications to the production plan and product.

In Area of Study 3, students should be able to evaluate the effectiveness and efficiency of techniques they used and the quality of their product with reference to design criteria and end-user feedback. Students should be able to make judgments about possible improvements. They should be able to produce user instructions that highlight the product's features for an end-user.
