Small Business Practice

This is an introductory course aimed at providing students with an overview of small business practices which equip students with the necessary skills to study VCE Business Management and participate effectively in the business community. Topics covered include: entrepreneurship, innovation, types of business ownership, e-commerce (online business practice), marketing, planning, accounting and record keeping. Students apply theoretical business knowledge to practical business situations. Students will work within a team to run their own school based small business.

Subject specific skills for this area are:

- You will demonstrate skills required to successfully plan and manage a small business
- You will use the inquiry process to investigate, analyse and interpret information
- You will make informed economic and consumer decisions, demonstrating the development of personal financial literacy
