

# College Uniform Policy

At Overnewton Anglican Community College school uniform is an integral part of developing a sense of identity for our students. It develops unity and, when worn well, demonstrates a sense of pride and attachment to the Overnewton community. It provides equity and allows students to be judged by their underlying qualities and personal character, rather than superficial aspects of their appearance.

The following Student Uniform Policy provides the guidelines for students to know each item of uniform and when and how they are to be worn.

College uniform and general appearance form part of the learning environment in which teachers and students are working collaboratively to develop the best learning outcomes, where the classroom is a place of learning, rather than a social venue.

We ask for your support by ensuring your children present themselves correctly for school so that we can focus on teaching and learning.

The College is the only supplier of Overnewton uniform items. With the exception of footwear, all other uniform items are available from the College Shop. Unless otherwise noted, all uniform items are compulsory. These must be kept clean, in good repair and fit properly.



Students are required to take responsibility to wear the correct uniform on the appropriate days according to their College timetable.

## Roles

Each member the College community has a role to play in the area of supporting the College Uniform Policy.

### College

The College is responsible for ensuring that the details of the College Uniform Policy are available to all members of the College community and that systems are in place to ensure that students are wearing their uniform appropriately.

### Students

At Overnewton, we strive to develop self-motivation and self-discipline in our students. They value quality of dress and appearance and are motivated to maintain this.

Students must be familiar with the College Uniform Policy and wear uniform accordingly both at school and at school related events and excursions.

Where students do not wear the uniform appropriately, the College may take action necessary to reinforce the College Uniform Policy.

### Parents

Parents should know and be supportive of the College Uniform Policy.

### Teachers

Teachers must be familiar with the College Uniform Policy and enforce it both at school and at school related events and excursions.
