## An update on Overnewton's exciting future.

In May this year, the College launched the Master Plan, which details plans for the future of Overnewton Anglican Community College. The Master Plan will see our two Junior Schools unite as one at **Canowindra Campus** (Taylors Lakes) and our two Middle Schools unite together at **Yirramboi Campus** (Keilor).

It was our intention for the new buildings to be completed and ready for students at the start of the 2020 school year. However, a variety of factors – including a number of specific constraints of the land at Keilor Campus - have affected our projected planning timeframes. The most recent building program has projected that the buildings will now be completed mid-2020.

As always, students are at the beginning and centre of every decision made at the College.

Accordingly, it is important that our students, especially our youngest students, benefit from a seamless transition into their new learning environments at the beginning of a new school year. Also, it is important that all landscaping and playgrounds are completed prior to students inhabiting the space.

**In light of this, the revised commencement date for this transition is the start of the 2021 school year.**

Works will commence on the Taylors Lakes Campus over the coming summer break. Demolition will occur on the portables, clearing space for the new Junior School building to be constructed. The campus will look very different when our students return in 2019.

Work on the new oval at Keilor will begin early in 2019 to provide play space and enable the construction of the new Middle School on the existing soccer pitch.

In the New Year, we look forward to providing further details of the new buildings, including 3D renders and plans. Towards the middle of March, 2019, we will schedule an information session, at which families will be able to view the plans and renders and ask questions of associated staff and school leaders.

We are aware that many families have been planning for the change to occur at the start of 2020. However, we are sure that the ongoing work that is being undertaken for the construction of our new facilities, as well as the logistics associated with the changes that will occur, will only benefit from another year of careful planning.
