This year is the 70th birthday of the establishment of the CBCA in Australia. The first Children's Book Week was held in November, 1945. World War II had just ended and there were many shortages and restrictions that made life difficult. The International Children's Book Week Slogan, *United through Books*, inspired a group of volunteers to form the CBC in N.S.W. They aimed to provide incentive to writers, illustrators and publishers to produce children's literature of the highest standards. By 1959 it had become a national organization with branches in all states and territories.
