I CAN Network's programs create communities that benefit from embracing Autism. This is achieved through mentoring students on the Spectrum on a fortnightly basis. The mentoring is unique because it is largely delivered by successful young adults on the Spectrum. Our mentoring sessions have been designed to build social interaction, self-awareness, self-confidence, problem-solving, teamwork, and above all, having fun and encouraging people to say 'I CAN' when facing difficulty.

This year, the I CAN Network will offer 15 students on the spectrum aged 14 - 18 the opportunity to attend a fortnightly mentoring session held in Keilor on a Monday night from 6pm till 8pm. This invitation is for families who are connected primarily to the Autism Angels.
