



## Senior School House Swimming Carnival Guidelines

The Swimming Carnival is held on Monday 15 February at the St Albans Swimming Pool. Information is included below for parents and students.

### **Clothing:**

Students are to come to School in sports uniform with bathers and House shirts.

Girls – One piece bathers are the most suitable and appropriate.

Boys – School sports shorts or suitable, appropriate swim wear.

Students competing in the volleyball event will wear a suitable t-shirt or vest whilst participating. Volleyball teams may compete wearing tops in their House colours.

All students may wear and swim in rash vests at the carnival.

**ALL students wear their OACC house tops when not competing.** The exception to this is Year 12 students.

Year 12 students may wear house coloured fancy dress at St. Albans pool. However, they come to school in correct sports uniform, change at the venue and change back into sports uniform before departing from the venue in full sports uniform.

### **Timings:**

Bus departs from Keilor: 9.00 a.m.

Bus returns: 3.20 p.m.

### **Lunch**

Students may bring their own snacks, drinks and lunch. The kiosk will be open and students may make purchases. A water fountain will also be provided.

**Seating:**

Students base themselves in their House areas when not competing.

**General:**

All students should wear hats and provide their own sun block. Whistles, hooters, water pistols are not permitted and they will be confiscated immediately if they are brought. Prior to departure from the pool, all students must be correctly dressed, including correct footwear.
