Our Master Plan

In an exciting development, Overnewton Anglican Community College is moving into the future with a new Master Plan that covers both of its campuses.

Students are at the beginning and centre of all decisions made for the College.

Therefore, from 2020, Overnewton's two Junior Schools will be combined into one at the Taylors Lakes Campus, and the two Middle Schools will become one on the Keilor Campus.

The consolidation is an extension of our 2017 Strategic Plan, 'Taking the Alpha Generation to Excellence'.

The Master Plan has been adopted by the College Board after careful consideration of all factors, including advice from education and financial experts.

Class sizes will remain the same, and Overnewton is focussed on an even greater sense of 'being, belonging, becoming'.

What's in a Name?

To reflect this exciting new direction, we will be renaming our campuses.

Since 1998, the name **Canowindra** meaning 'a home or meeting point' has been synonymous with the Year Nine Centre. As the newly developed Junior School will become the meeting point for students joining the College, the entire campus will adopt that name.

The College Vision Statement: 'a community of learners, embracing the future' is reflected in the new name of our Keilor Campus: **Yiramboi**. In the shared languages of the Boon Wurrung and Wurundjeri peoples of the Kulin Nations, **Yiramboi** means: 'tomorrow/the future'.

Overnewton College, Canowindra Campus will provide a stable learning environment for young students.

Overnewton College, Yiramboi Campus will be a place where good education provides the pathway for older students toward a successful future.

We know that families choose to send their children to the College because of our strong inclusive community.

Inclusivity means that people of all nationalities, cultures, religions, the gender and sexually diverse, the introverted, the extroverted and our first people all are treated as equals and all can safely and fairly access a good education.

The College name **Overnewton** reflects settlement by the Taylors Family as squatters and the Anglo-European history of this area.

Yiramboi and **Canowindra** will help us to acknowledge our connection with the indigenous history of this land. These campus names reflect the reality that we are a community that embraces diversity and the richness of culture and language that comes with it.

Setting the Foundations

Portable classrooms will be replaced with architecturally designed, spacious, light-filled modern buildings. Current Middle School facilities will be renovated and refurbished to modern education design criteria, meeting the requirements of our Junior School students.

Prep to Year 4 students will thrive in classrooms equipped with state-of-the-art teaching technologies and ergonomic furnishings. Play areas will be tailored to their needs and designed to stimulate their minds in an environment dedicated solely to them.

Students will now have equal access to resources and facilities, and the entire Junior School teaching staff all in one location.

We will pique their interest and fuel their curiosity in an age-appropriate environment.

Maximising our Assets

A combined Middle School complex will be created on the Keilor grounds, providing greater access to a wealth of existing and new resources.

The current Junior School building will be renovated and refurbished to meet the requirements of a modern Middle School learning environment, as well as building a new facility adjacent, to cater for Year 5 to Year 8 students. The old Middle School portables on this campus will be removed.

These state-of-the-art facilities will be home to exciting, new, future-focussed programs for our Middle School students and will provide a more rewarding experience for the teachers who strive to make a difference in their students' lives.

Situated close to our newly acquired land, the Middle School will be connected to the planned garden-farms that will complement our new food technology programs.

All Middle School students will share specialised College resources with Senior School students, such as advanced science laboratories, computer laboratories, and music, drama and sporting facilities, in order to enrich their learning.

Middle School students will be able to explore and excel on their own education pathway, and they'll all be able to look forward to an easier transition to Senior School on a familiar campus among familiar faces.

With the improved usage of land available, we will also be able to introduce the planned new garden-farms at both campuses, to complement our new food technology programs and free up essential space for future needs as they arise.

Our 2030 Strategic Plan, released in 2017, recognised the importance of STEM education, and our science laboratories will be improved and customised on both campuses as part of the new construction.

Indeed, our development strategies and enhanced learning programs are largely due to the input of our staff and their desire to improve their students' learning experience and academic success.
