He was an invited panel member of the Psychology panel for the World Economic Forum as well as several government committees and has been an invited speaker at more than 50 domestic and international conferences. He has also held consulting contracts for the Australian Rugby Union and Carlton Football Club and designed the IQ test for the Channel 9 TV show "Test the Nation".
